Leader Advancement Scholarship

The Leader Advancement Scholarship awards 40 Michigan high school seniors who have distinguished themselves through their records of leadership and service with an \$8000 scholarship - \$2000 per academic year - to enroll in CMU's renowned leadership development program.

In addition to the 40 Leader Scholarship recipients, an additional 60 students will receive the Leadership Distinction Award, valued at \$3,000.

How to apply
