

#### 7th-12th grade ski trip to Crystal Mountain

Efforts to plan and execute the 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade ski trip to Crystal Mountain just got a little more complicated as our bus is once again out of service. Several other bussing options have been explored but are unavailable to us at this time.

In order for this trip to happen, we will need parent volunteer drivers to transport 60 students to and from Crystal Mountain on Thursday, Feb. 22<sup>nd</sup>. Drivers will leave school at 8:15am and return students to school around 2:30pm. All volunteer drivers MUST have an ichat form and volunteer driver form on file at the school by Tuesday, Feb. 20<sup>th</sup>. If you are able to drive students, please call/text Nicole Pierce at 231-944-5172 by Monday, Feb. 19<sup>th</sup>. The decision to take the trip will be made on Tuesday, February 20. If we don't have enough drivers with the required documents by Tuesday, February 20, we will have to cancel.

Also, all students received permission slips to be signed and returned to school by Tuesday. We are waiting on a rental waiver from Crystal Mountain. This will either be an online link or a paper form sent home on Monday to be returned Tuesday as well.



#### How to Access Hallow Plus for FREE through Easter:

- Step 1: Go to http://hallow.com/holyday
- Step 2: Search for Divine Mercy Parish, Manistee MI, in the search box. Click Continue. You should see Welcome Divine Mercy Parish Parishioner! "Free Until Easter Sunday"
- Step 3: If you don't have an account, you can creat one by choosing any of three options: Continue with Phone or Email; Continue with Google, or Continue with Apple.
- Step 4: After you hit register you will continue to a screen where you can download the hallow app and login the same way you just did, or you may sign in using your email.
- Step 5: Confirm in your Account Settings that you have a free subscription through Easter!
