### PCI: Parent Community Involvement

#### **Requirements:**

- K-12 families: A minimum of 15 service/volunteer hours per semester per family. Not required for preschool-only families.
- 6 hours of HARVEST volunteer hours (in addition to the required 15 hours per semester)
- Hours must be submitted via FACTS (Previously Renweb) no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup> for each semester:

Our Parent Community Involvement (PCI) is designed to involve parents in the life of the school. Your time and talent is an integral part of many programs at MCC: the Harvest, playground, lunch and recess, athletics, committees, classroom parents, field trip chaperones, etc. are all important elements to the life of our school. It is important that parents participate in the total educational experience of their children and PCI helps to provide this opportunity.

#### **Program Goals:**

- MCC's community serves as a model for students to become servant leaders.
- Fully staff our revenue generating events. The school's operating budget is dependent on the success of the Harvest, fundraisers and activities, etc... The success of these events is dependent on the hard work and dedication of our families.
- Create a welcoming environment for each of our families by involving our parents/guardians in events throughout the year. We are more than a school for your child. Through PCI we strengthen our community.
- Maintain lower tuition rates by having the parents/guardians of our students fulfill many of the responsibilities that may otherwise require paid positions.

The cost per student is \$7055. Of this cost: 27% comes from parish contributions, 11% comes from fundraising, 10% from grants and gifts, and 52% from tuition. These numbers consider our entire school community.

**\*\*\* Families unable to meet the required number of service hours will pay an additional fee of \$150 (per semester). Unmet obligations will be added to the family's bill following the semester\*\*\***

*Specific programs with volunteer requirements such as Washington Group and the Rome Pilgrimage are separate and should not be counted toward PCI requirements for each family and student. Please contact MCC staff if you have any questions regarding opportunities that will fulfill PCI requirements.*
